Due to our personal situation, there is far too much work to expect my children to complete all of it at home. I think the children would have been motivated to do more with more encouraging comments from teachers throughout.	<i>In the event of future lockdown, lessons (personalised to your child's ability group) will be uploaded to seesaw in order to motivate and inspire all pupils and ensure access for all.</i>
50% of pupils feel anxious about returning to school	<i>Physical and mental wellbeing are key priorities in our curriculum, particularly on return to school after such a long period of time away. Your child's class teacher will ensure their educational and pastoral needs are met. Our highly skilled and experienced care team are also available to support those children with significant needs around emotional or mental wellbeing.</i>
62% of parents feel anxious about their child's return to school	<i>We will provide clear, timely communication around the measures we have taken to keep your child safe in school. School leaders will be visible at drop off and collection time and available to support with queries.</i>
The seesaw app was difficult.	<i>We have already provided training sessions on how to access/use the seesaw app but more information for parents will follow shortly. Pupils will be shown how to use the app in class.</i>

We found the English and reading too hard, but the maths easier.	<i>Going forward, the maths and English work will be set by your child's English and maths teachers and therefore will be closely matched to their ability.</i>
One child found online learning considerably more difficult than her siblings.	<i>Homework will be set using seesaw but will be differentiated to match the ability of your child and will focus on</i>

He struggled to understand and got frustrated.	<i>Teachers will have the ability to share the homework with children in advance of them completing it at home in order to avoid anxiety, confusion or frustration.
