Weekly dinner menus could be given to parents

Will be published on the website as from March 2017 so parents can read the menus with their children and help them think about their choices.

Electronic letters home

We will be Tweeting/informing via ParentPay when an important letter comes home for the whole school, but we are not able to manage this on a small group basis eg letters re clubs. Electronic versions of all our whole school letters are available on the website.

More space in after school clubs

We are currently reviewing our provision for out of school care which is being shared with 2 year old provision. Our vision is to provide both, alongside 30 hours for 3 year olds so we are exploring the possibilities for where this could be sited.

Get washable whiteboard pens

We have tried many times but can't find any on the market at a reasonable cost.

More feedback from homework

Due to time constraints, homework is reviewed each week with the children and feedback is given to inform next steps. This is where research shows feedback to be the most effective.

More time to meet with class teachers (not just to discuss academic progress in English and Maths)

We are currently discussing the option of a termly drop in session for parents to meet with the class teacher on an informal basis. As ever, if parents have any concerns or issues they need to share or discuss, appointments across the year can always be made directly with the class teacher.

Reception parents would like an additional report about their child's progress mid-year.

We agree and will look at a suitable format and time and implement this from September 2017.

Letters home are not always received when children are absent.

We will review procedures for ensuring children who have been absent receive letters when they return (name on or put in tray).
