Jesus arrived in Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. People waves palm leaves to welcome him




The Last Supper
Jesus shared the Passover meal with his friends. Jesus shares bread and wine. He says one of his friends will betray him – Judas.



Good Friday
On Good Friday, Christians remember the day that Jesus was crucified for their sins.

Easter Sunday
On Easter Sunday, Christians believe that Jesus was resurrected. The stone was rolled away. An angel told Mary Magdalene that Jesus had risen from the dead.
