Attendance and Punctuality

Attendance and Punctuality

Good attendance is the key to success for our children and therefore forms part of our LCPS vision: **Happy, Healthy, Here!**

Regular attendance at school is of the highest importance and is directly linked to pupil achievement. Whilst we would like all children to have 100% attendance, we realise that this is not always possible. Parents can ensure that their child has good attendance (96% or above) by making all doctor and dentist appointments outside of school time where possible and avoiding taking holidays during term time.

The table below gives an example of the amount of lost learning due to pupil absence:
